Subject: PERMISSION FOR PROSECUTION

I along with a team of Drugs Inspectors, headed by, the Executive District Officer (Health) and comprising of Mr Azhar Jamal Saleemi, DI, Aziz Bhalti Town, Mr. Tashfeen Iqbal, DI, Samanabad Town, Mr. Bilal Yasin DI, Nishtar Town and Mr. Muhammad Jamil, Drugs Inspector, Gulberg, Town Lahore inspected the premises of M/S Pak National Pharmacy, situated at I/S Doctor's Hospital, 152/G-1, Johar Town, Lahore on 5-12-2009 at 7:45 P.M.

During inspection M/S Pak National Pharmacy was found involved in keeping/selling the expired, unregistered, unwarranted drugs, sale of drugs without maintaining sale/purchase record of controlled/narcotic/steroid drugs/medicines. I recovered and seized the drugs on Form No. 5 (Copy enclosed) from the custody of Ms. Ammara Butt, Qualified Person and Mr. Muhammad Shafeeq, Shift in charge in the presences of witnesses. Two samples were also taken for test/analysis on Form No 4 (Copy enclosed)

The premises was locked and sealed under section 18 (1) (h) of the Drugs Act, 1976 and a Rappat in this regard was also got registered in the PS, Johar Town, Lahore (Copy enclosed). It is added that the premises being open and without having protective walls could not be properly closed. Therefore, the same was sealed with the sticking tapes.

It is added that during inspection of the Pharmacy, one Malik Khalid along with 12 other unknown persons gathered on the spot and obstructed during performance of official duties and threatened me and team for dire consequences. The SHO of the Johar Town Police Station was called for help and the inspection was completed with the help of police party An FIR was got registered in PS, Johar Town, Lahore to this effect (Copy enclosed)

You are requested to kindly grant necessary PERMISSION FOR PROSECUTION and permission custody of the seized drugs. The extension in the sealing time/period up to 90 days may also be granted.
